- **To measure the present condition and also take into account people's perception, Oxfam has conducted a survey in 13 districts of Bangladesh.**



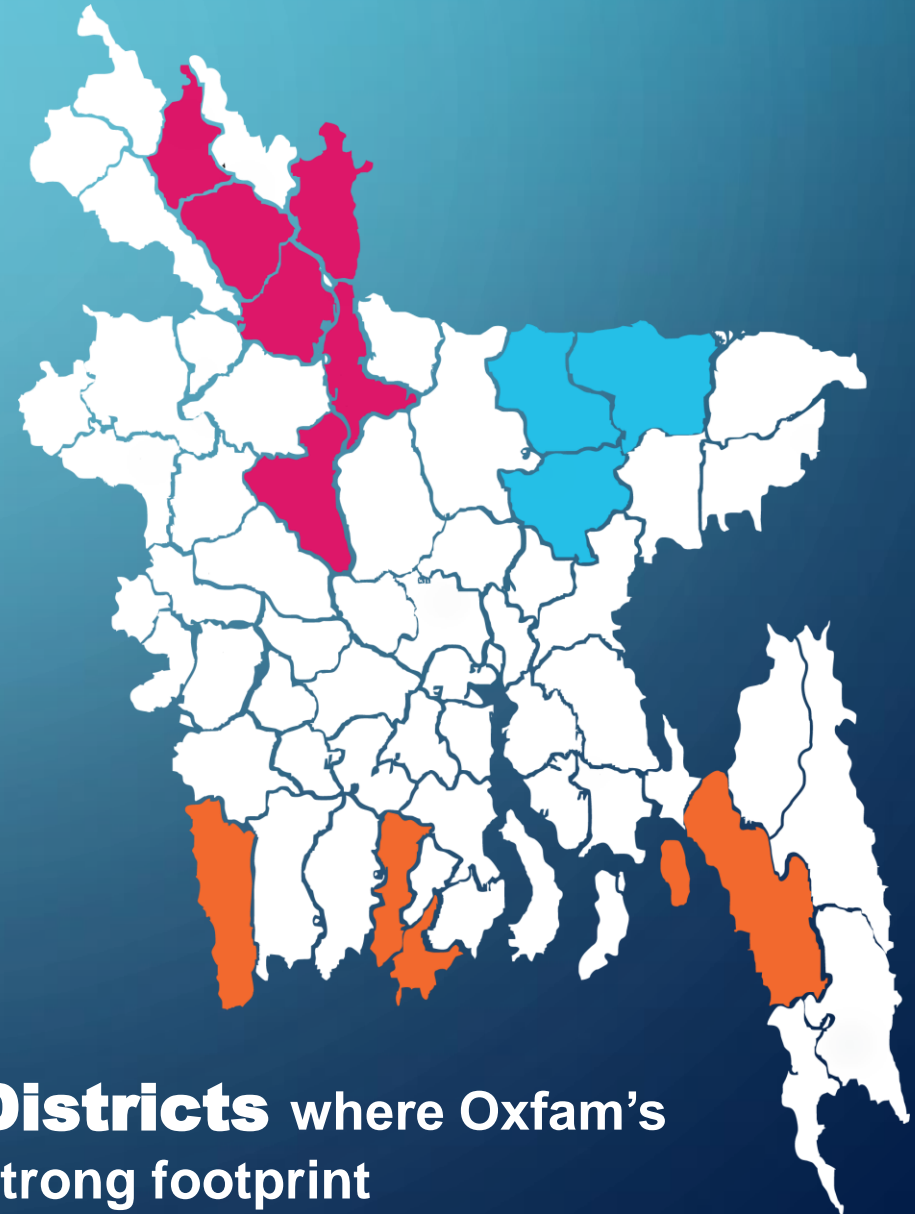

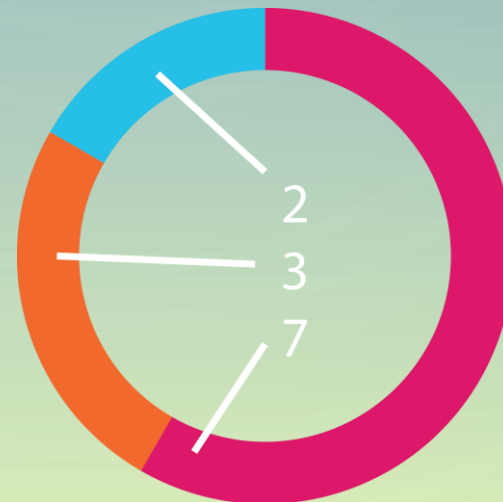

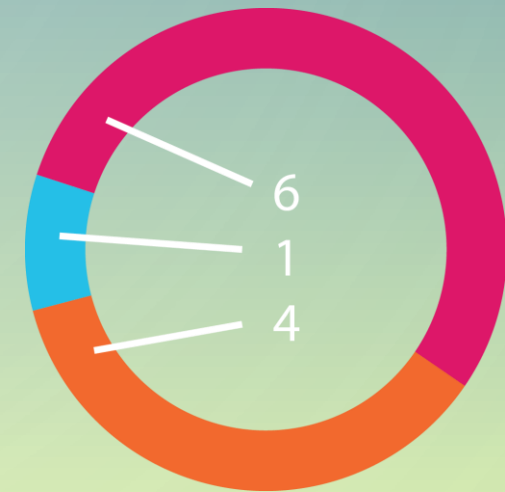

- **In connection with the need for capacity building of CBOs and networking amongst stakeholders, there is a need to elevate the level of understanding and facilitate the processes that enable Local Government and Local Authorities to internalize their roles and responsibilities.**

 - **To make the project outcomes sustainable, it is crucial that the Local Government and Local Actors create an enabling environment to ensure that development initiatives are jointly governed through the participation of the communities via transparent budgeting and effective implementation.**

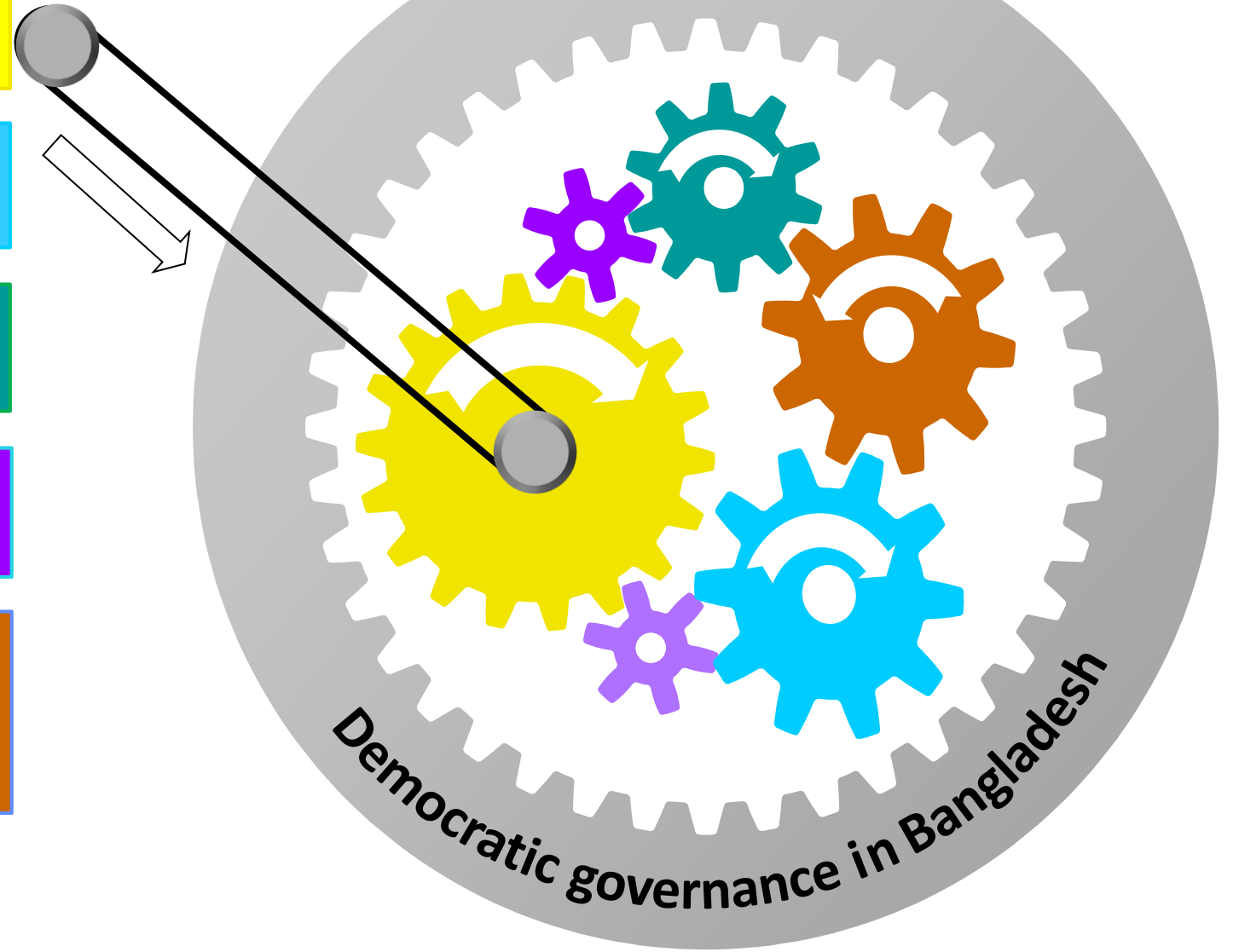

Result 2: CBOs and CSOs support LAs/LGs to effectively deliver people-centred services as per existing laws and policies relating to SDGs.



Result 3: Communities, CBOs, and CSOs hold LAs and interest groups accountable on existing laws and policies relating to SDGs



Result 4: Relevance and effectiveness of SDG framework is enhanced through contextualization at local, national and global levels

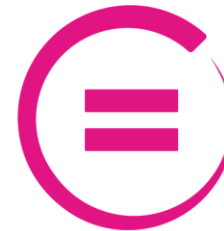

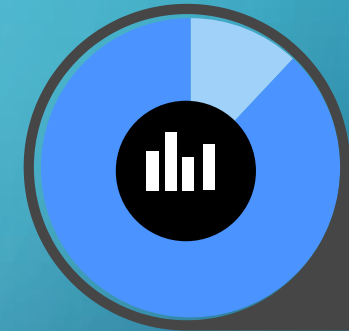
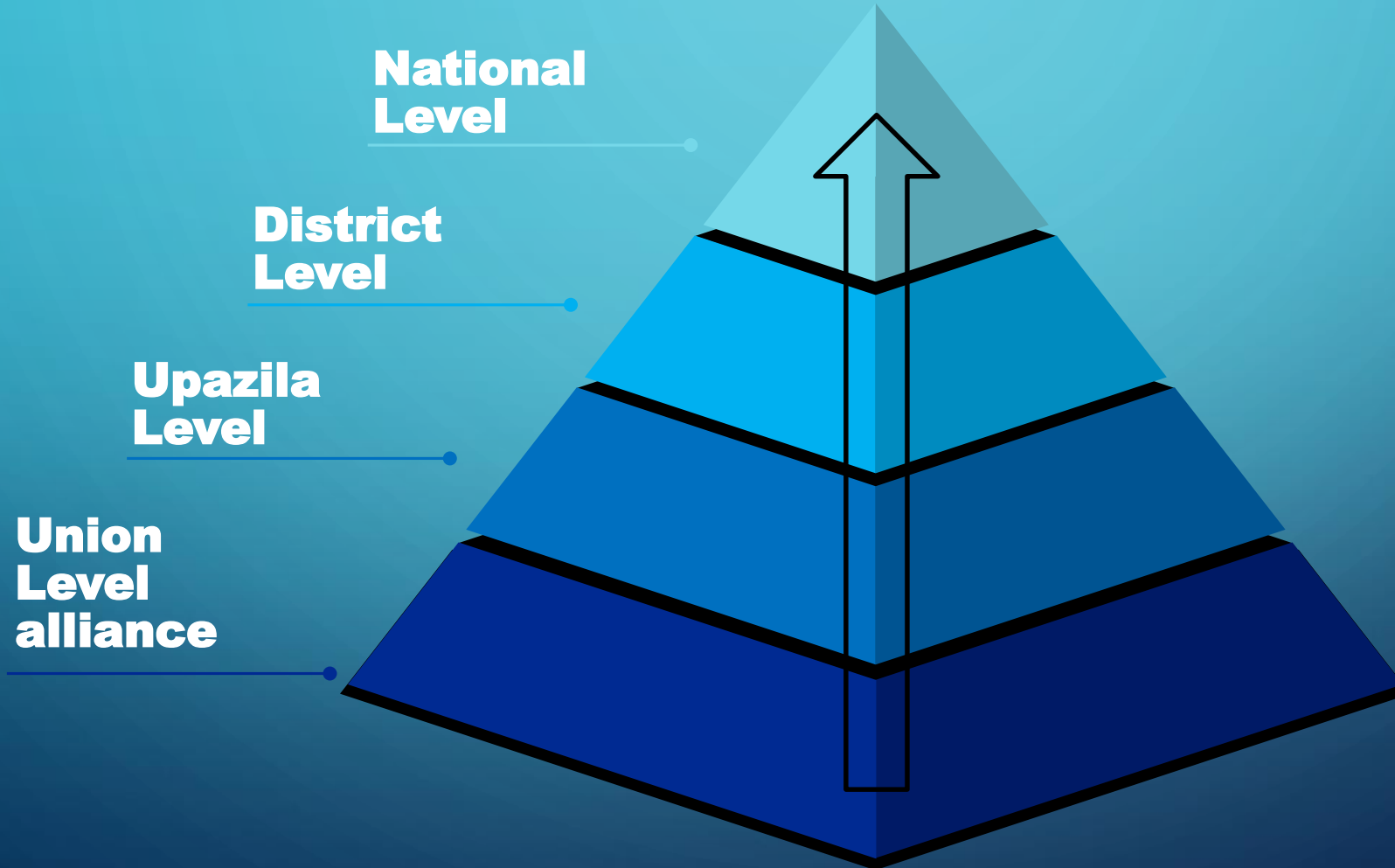
